This daughter and father duo is no stranger to the musical world of Fairfield County and beyond. Emily began her career with her talented parents, Bill and Maryann Hall through their prestigious program "Music For Children." She starred in numerous productions at Staples High School and then went out into the professional world of theater. Her credits include "Follies" (Broadway), "Gypsy" (St Louis), "Whistle Down the Wind (World Premiere and more. She released a solo CD of children's songs entitled "Sun in the Morning Til the Moon at Night" which recently won a Parent's Choice Award. More recently she released a new CD "All Things On My Mind" with original songs.

Most recently they were invited to perform at the home of University President, Dr. John Petillo for his annual Christmas Dinners and participated in "The Acapocalypse!" at Manhattanville College (NY), where they performed for other college a capella groups in an all-day convention. 
